## INSTRUCTIONS FOR PERSONAL REGISTRATION FORM

Return this completed form and your check made out to AAPRCO to: Diane Elliott, AAPRCO Convention, 630 B Constitution Avenue, NE, Washington, DC 20002. Questions should be directed to Diane at (202) 547-5696. Everyone riding the special trains must register by mail to insure your packet is aboard your train. Registration packets will be distributed in Chicago and Spokane prior to the train's departure. For those arriving in Missoula by other means, packets will be available at the hotel beginning at 5 pm Sept. 22<sup>nd</sup>. **The deadline for mail registration is August 15<sup>th</sup>.** We encourage all to register by mail so you can be listed in the Convention Program. It will be possible to register at the hotel but it's easier if all you need to do is pick up your packet.

Everyone must register for the convention. Convention registration includes convention pin, gift, program, meetings, seminars, two Car Parties, shuttle service between the station and hotel, and the cocktail reception at the old Missoula Depot. Crew registration (up to two per car) includes convention pin, program, meetings, seminars, the two Car Parties, and shuttle service. AAPRCO membership is required to attend the convention (family, crew and a guest of a member) are excepted. An Associate membership is offered through the end of 2004 for \$90. Separate security badges will again be provided for the special trains and for access to the cars at Missoula and convention activities.

For those of you traveling on the special trains, there is a flyer detailing some options for visits to Yellowstone and Glacier National Parks. Montana Rockies Rail Tours (800-519-7245) will be happy to handle registrations for these tours for individuals or groups. You may want to check with the owner of the car that you're riding to see if tour arrangements have been made for your group.

There are four optional activities in Missoula. On Friday, there will be a special train departing Missoula at 8:30 am for Hamilton with an 11 am arrival. This is the scenic and historic *Bitterroot Valley*. *There will be a barbecue lunch served on the grounds of the Daly Mansion, the 42-room estate of one of Montana's famous "Copper Kings".* Tours of the mansion are included in the price of \$75 per person. The train will arrive back in Missoula at 5 pm. Light refreshments will be served on the train. For those not attending the AAPRCO meetings/seminars, there are three optional excursions for \$15 each. The first is a tour on Thursday morning of the Aerial Fire Depot & Smokejumper Center. This is the nation's largest training base for smokejumpers who parachute into the remote areas of national forests to fight wildfires. The second trip is a guided motorcoach tour of the city, with a one-hour tour of the famed Children's Theatre on Thursday afternoon between 1 – 3 pm. The third trip is a self-guided visit to the Ninemile Remount Depot and Ranger District on Saturday morning from 9 am to Noon. Learn the history of early firefighting in the northern Rockies using mules and packers. In Missoula, there will also be an opportunity to tour Montana Rail Link's Central Control. You will be able to sign up for that tour at the AAPRCO Registration Desk in the hotel.
